Margin Rates & Key Statistics

Reduced Risk of Cancer Recurrence:

- Margins are evaluated by a pathologist after surgical removal of the prostate
- A positive margin means the presence of cancer at the surgical boundary of resection
- The presence of a positive margin increases risk of recurrence of cancer following prostate removal
- Positive margin rates of 15-17% are commonly reported with open surgery from other large volume prostate cancer centers
- Our positive margin rate from 2010 Present is 4.4%

Surgical removal of the prostate using the daVinci Robot has many advantages for patients, including faster recoveries, reduced side effects, improved quality of life and reduced risk of cancer recurrence.

REDUCED SIDE EFFECTS

Urinary Continence

<u>98%</u> regain full urinary function within one year of surgery

Erectile Function

Nearly <u>60%</u> of patients able to have erections sufficient for intercourse 3 months after surgery

70% report normal erections 9 months after surgery.

These outcomes reflect results for patients with normal baseline erections who underwent nerve preservation at the time of surgery.

IMPROVED QUALITY OF LIFE

Urinary Functioning

<u>85%</u> of patients are satisfied with their urinary function 3 months after surgery
100% of patients are satisfied with their urinary function 12 months after surgery

Reduced Symptoms

Most patients report only mild urinary symptoms 6 months following surgery

REDUCED RISK OF CANCER RECURRENCE

Positive Margin Rate

<u>4.4%</u> (Positive margin is the presence of cancer at the site where the prostate was surgically removed. Its presence increases risk of cancer recurrence. The national average positive margin rate for prostatectomies is 15-17%.)
